Errata & Additional Information

p7	The vase on the left has been confirmed as being by Söndgen.
p9	Ruscha 313 jugs in the Vulkano glaze are rare.
p10	This vase is 10in (25.5cm) high.
p13	Early, hand-assembled Ruscha 313 jugs have smaller openings. Later, moulded examples have bulkier necks and handles.
p14	The pattern on this dish is Bali, dating from the same period.
p27	This may have been released in four different sizes.
p35	This was designed by Bodo Mans.
p40	The model number is 1251-33.
p45	This is from the Luxus range, and was sold in different sizes with a chain.
p48	Hans Welling died in 2008.
p84	This form is rare.
p85	The green glaze is very hard to find.
p101	A similar jug vase, but with a tall octagonal body with three moulded petals, an angular double handle, and a similar neck has been found.
p105	Übelacker Keramik did produce low rectangular 'chimney' vases.
p143	The Montignac range is proving to be comparatively scarce.

As well as being tube-lined, 'lava' glazes were sprayed on using an 'aerosol' method.
